Clean Energy Tax Policy is Bipartisan Opportunity for Jobs and Climate Action

Washington, D.C. - The BCSE released [a letter](#) to Congressional leaders on tax policy, including the House of Committee on Ways and Means Chairman Richard Neal and Ranking Member Kevin Brady and the Senate Committee on Finance Chairmen Ron Wyden and Ranking Member Mike Crapo, encouraging the pursuit of bipartisan measures to support the deployment of a diverse portfolio of clean energy technologies.

“Today’s Senate Finance Committee markup on the Clean Energy for America Act is an opportunity for bipartisan work towards an updated and more effective tax policy for clean energy in America. Our members have seen the investment in clean energy wax and wane due to policy uncertainty over the past decade, and BCSE urges Congress to adopt technology-inclusive and long-term tax incentives to drive new clean energy jobs and accelerate the energy transition. The strongest impact comes from tax policy that is in sync with industries’ investment and project development cycles.” commented BCSE President Lisa Jacobson.
