She joined Sempra in 2015 and is the primary liaison to policymakers, advocating on behalf of Sempra before the U.S. Congress, the Administration and federal agencies, including the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC), the Environmental Protection Agency and the Departments of Energy, Defense and Interior.

Ms. Hull serves as the Chairman of the Board of the National Energy Resources Organization, a non-partisan organization whose mission is to engage in dialogue on energy issues with Members of Congress and other legislators and regulators. In addition, she is Vice Chairman of the Board of Directors for the Business Council for Sustainable Energy.
