

State Initiatives Task Force 2008 Accomplishments and Advocacy

2008 Objectives

- Work with California and Western Climate Initiative (WCI) on policy implementation.
- Secure allowance value for clean energy and energy efficiency through RGGI.

2008 Accomplishments

- Inclusion of offsets program in WCI design recommendations: up to 49% of required reductions allowed from offsets between 2012-2020; no restrictions on voluntary offset market; offset credits allowed from developing countries through use of Clean Development Mechanism.
- A portion of the value represented by each WCI Partner jurisdiction's allowance budget will be dedicated to energy efficiency and renewable energy incentives and achievement; research development, demonstrations, and deployment (RDD&D) with particular reference to renewable energy generation, transmission and storage; and energy efficiency, in addition to carbon capture & sequestration, and for other uses.
- Further developed relationships with staff from key states and advancement of Council policy priorities.
- Defeat of AB1851 (SB1762) in the California State legislature, which would have had a detrimental effect on the voluntary offset market in California, and would have superimposed Court authority over how to implement AB32 (the Global Warming Solutions Act) and the compliance market. The legislation would have also had the unintended effect of regulating the marketing and distribution of voluntary Renewable Energy Credits (RECs).
